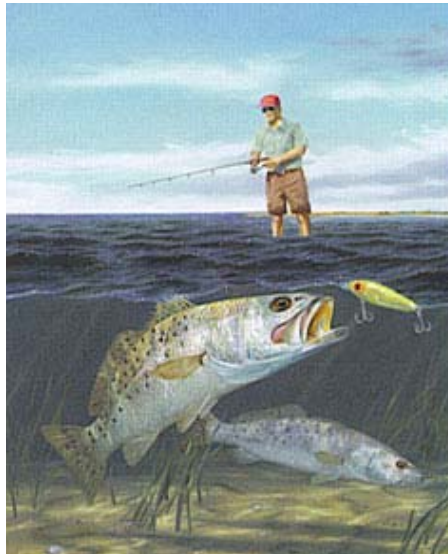

Oyster Roast

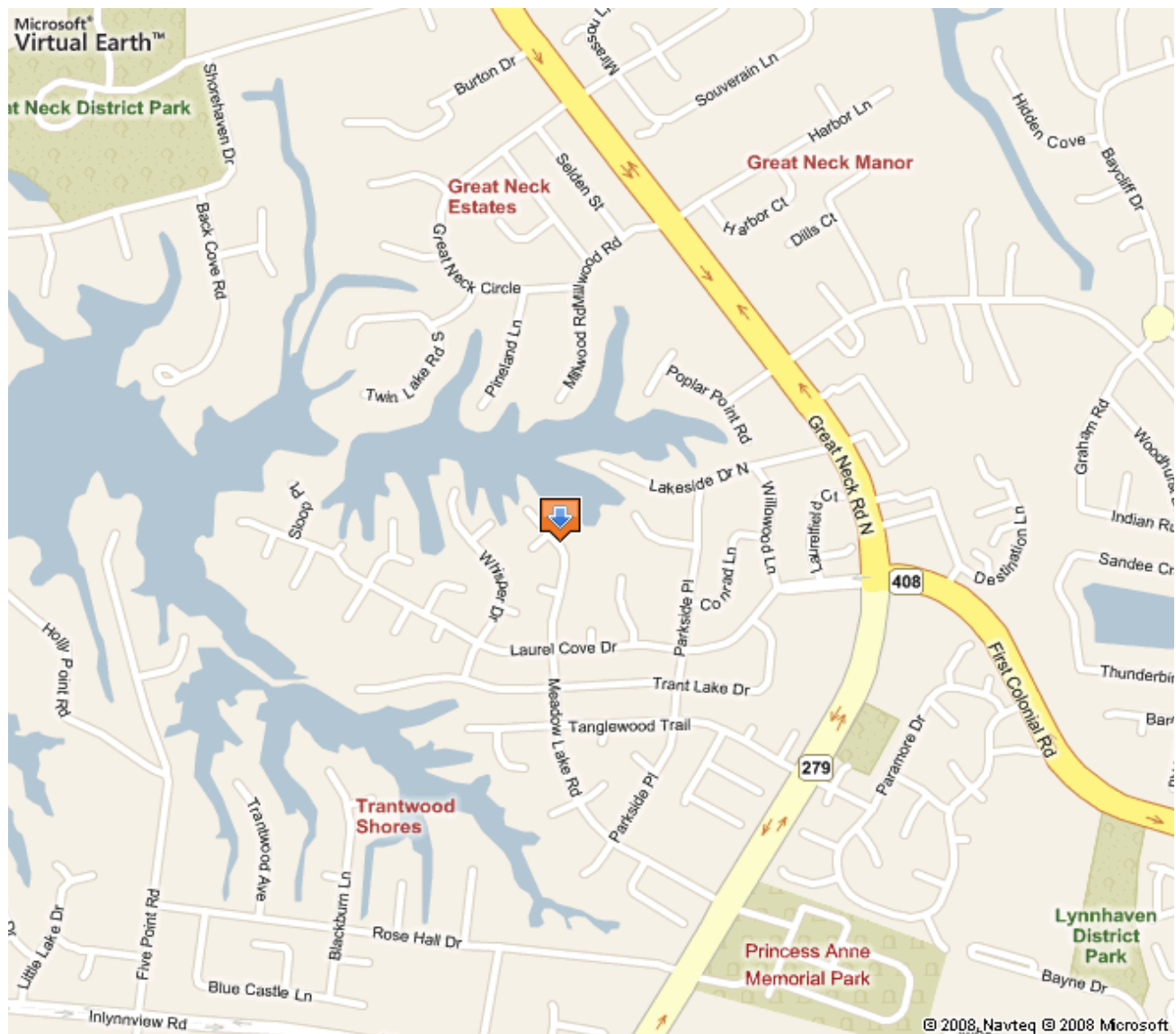
October 5, 2008 12:00 till 4:00

Steve Wray's home is located at 1328 Meadow Lake Rd. in the Laurel Cove section of Virginia Beach.

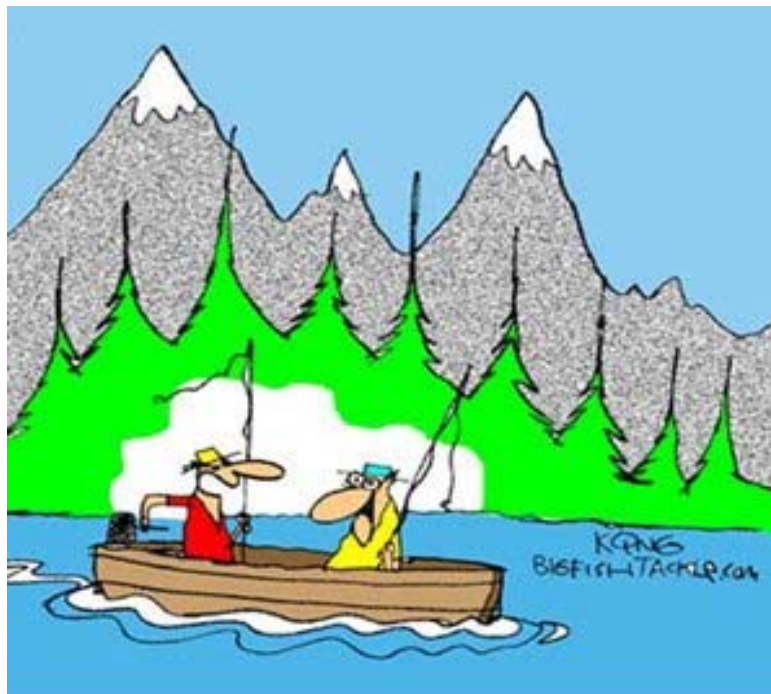
