Giving Back to our Community Virginia Beach ADAPT-A-SPOT program

Our Club has been granted an ADOPT-A-SPOT/ WATERWAY on the Lynnhaven Inlet and Chesapeake Bay at 'Crab Creek Boat Ramp/ Lynnhaven Beach in Virginia Beach. We signed up to perform a clean-up of the beach area at the Crab Creek Boat Ramp beginning January, 2011. Our commitment to this worthy endeavor requires that we conduct 6 clean-ups per year. The board has scheduled the clean-ups to take place the Saturday following our monthly meetings; of Jan, March, May, July, Sept, Nov We anticipate meeting in the parking lot at Crab Creek by 10:00 am Saturday mornings to begin our session. The club will serve a hot dog lunch to our volunteers at each session.

The City will erect a sign acknowledging the VBAC voluntary clean-up effort. Make sure you schedule the time and bring your kids to participate in this community service project. For those kids preparing their resumes for college, this will serve as a noteworthy community service project.



The VBAC Fishing Roulette

We are going to try something new this year, to add a little friendly competition amongst the club's anglers. Let me introduce the VBAC Fishing Roulette Challenge— Here's how it works— interested club members put \$20 in a pot (Mike Anderson holds the pot) before the Feb meeting. At the February monthly meeting, we will draw the names (species) of five fish from the club's leader board*. 
2010 VBAC Year in Review


Last year was an event filled year for the members of VBAC. In case you've forgotten, let me remind you of the many events that VBAV sponsored, organized, and supported for its members:


- A year of the TightLines News Letter






