
Let's keep it up. The attendants' at the boat ramp are very appreciative of all our hard work. Thank you again for all your support.



As we approach the home stretch for this year's Prize Fish Contest, please remember that in order to be considered for an end-of-year award, fish must meet the club's minimum weight or length requirement. Length only applies to those fish which are not eligible to be weighed, e.g. channel bass. We do recommend recording length and girth; these may be needed to break a tie if two fish have identical weights. More details can be obtained from the club's Functions and Activities Manual which can be accessed on our web site. Enough for now; go catch a fish!


