### The VBAC Fishing Roulette

The second VBAC Fishing Roulette Challenge is underway. The five species of fish for 2012 are: sunfish, blue catfish, chain pickerel, flounder, and tautog. 26 people signed up and will be competing for the prize money. The angler with the heaviest catch for the selected species by Dec 31, 2012 will share the pot with the other winners. Weight will determine winner (not length).

\*(Wahoo, Tuna, Gar and Amberjack will not be part of the drawing)

### "Hunt for the Hardheads" Fishing Challenge

A croaker, bluefish, and flounder fishing challenge between the Great Bridge Fisherman's Association, Portsmouth Anglers Club, and the Virginia Beach Anglers Club will be held on Saturday, May 12, 2012 at the Willoughby Public Boat Ramp (13<sup>th</sup> View St. and Bayville St. Norfolk, VA). Lines in at 7AM and 'measure in' is between 12:30 and 1:30PM. Entry Fee: \$30.00 / Boat (3 angler teams). Additional Anglers \$10.00. Includes: Fishing, Picnic and Wish A Fish Donation (Picnic only is \$5).

- RULES:1. Club may enter as many teams as they would like. Team Captains must be club members.
  - 2. Teams must register and pay in advance through their own club's tournament director.
  - 3. Boats may depart from any VA port.
  - 4. The eastern boundary will be 500 yards east of the HRBT.
  - 5. Fish will be measured by length only, if the exact length is encountered a girth measurement will decide.
  - 6. Points Structure... The longest legal fish of each species will earn 5 points, the 2<sup>nd</sup> longest legal earns 4 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> longest legal fish earns 3 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> longest legal fish earns 2pts., and the 5<sup>th</sup> longest legal fish earns 1pt.
  - 7. The Club with the Most Points Wins!

### LEGISLATIVE NEWS

#### **VMRC Info**

Currently Governor Robert F. McDonnell has named has named Jack Travelstead Acting Commissioner of VMRC. He will serve as Acting Commissioner until the Governor makes a permanent appointment. He replaces Steven Bowman. Mr. Travelstead named Rob O'Reilly as Acting Chief of the agency's Fisheries Management Division and Joe Grist as Acting Deputy Chief of that Division.

2012 Fishing regs:

The Commission approved 16 ½" minimum size and 4 fish possession at the meeting today. Regulation effective 3/1/12.

Under the recreational black sea bass rules and regulations from VMRC, 25 fish per fisherman per day with a 12 1/2 inch minimum length are allowed. The season is from May 19th through October 14th and November 1st through December 31st.




