

Ierry Hughes asked the DMV what will happen after July 1st when the 17.5 cents fuel tax goes away. They responded that the refund system isn't going away. You will still be able to apply for refunds. Fuel tax will be calculated differently based on the average wholesale price of the fuel.

Research Participation

NOAA Ship Okeanos Explorer is currently conducting engineering field trials of our new 6.000 meter ROV in the Atlantic Canyons region. All the dives will be streamed live and community members are invited to follow along from home or office, as well as participate in live observation and discussion in the eventlog.

For those of you who have worked with NOAA before, you should be able to log in already. For those of you who have not, the "eventlog" is instant messaging and a group chat room. Please contact Brian (rbadds@cox.net) if you would like access to the eventlog to record your observations and add science value to these dives. Rain or shine.

Fish must be: caught on pier during tournament times, alive when brought to judging table, of legal size

Winner in each species will be determined by length.

Tie breaker: winner is the angler who caught/measured their fish first.

Winners do not have to be present at 6 PM.

All prize money will be awarded*. If no entry in a species, prize money will be divided and awarded to the winner with largest entry in remaining species.


