

# Community Update

November 22- The VA Saltwater Sport Fishing Tournament Advisory Committee voted to end part of the citation program. All levels of master angler past 1 have been eliminated for 2014. The system was set up so at each level (Master level 1, 2, 3 etc.), you had to catch 25 citations. Only one citation per species per year would count towards the 25 total. Also, to qualify for each level, you would have to have a certain number of different species. After getting level 1, you would need five more different species in your total count, level 2: 10 different species in the total count from level I and II. Then level 3: 15 different species from the total count of 75 citations from level 1, 2 and 3. Because there are only so many species, the levels end. It is my understanding that a level was given that was mathematically impossible so the committee decide to

eliminate the program instead of fixing the problem. Personally, I have used the program to set goal and push myself to fish for different species out of my comfort zone and to go fishing when I would want to same it is to cold, to hot, to calm, to windy, to sunny, to rainy or any other excuse. It is my understanding that not every committee member was in favor of this action, including Lewis Gillingham who is head of the citation program. Also it is my understanding that Lewis does not vote; only the committee members vote on it. 


