

Child's prize will be for largest fish caught that day from the three species. Please park in lot across the street from pier in parking slots 22 or greater.







## **Conservation and Regulations**

Provided by various individuals, conservation organizations, and regulation commissions.

National Parks & Federal Recreational Lands Pass: The lifetime "America the Beautiful Senior Pass" will increase from \$10 to \$80 on August 28, 2017. The lifetime pass provides access and entrance to single, private, non-commercial vehicles at federally operated recreation sites across the country. The current \$10 pass is available online or at the Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge office in person.

BBNWR is only open Thursday-Monday, 8-3:30pm. The annual senior pass will increase to \$20 per year as well. You can access more information or purchase your annual/lifetime pass here:

**Virginia Game Fish Tagging Program – 2016 Annual Report:** In early July, VIMS released their annual tagging program report. Up to 200 fishermen in the state of Virginia voluntarily collect data and tag fish to release in the Chesapeake Bay and Virginia ocean. Their annual report details all related numbers and some statistical analysis of the previous year's programs.

Mid-Atlantic Fishery Management Council MAFMC: Amendment 6 to the Tilefish Fishery Management Plan would manage the federal waters blueline tilefish fishery north of the Virginia/North Carolina border. The restrictions would cut the allowable creel limit for Charter and Recreational boaters. There would also be a required permit reporting process (already in place in Virginia) that would require a landing permit with reporting requirements. Comments are due by August 14, 2017. VIMS: Kepone could soon be history in the James River: This article is written and available at the daily press website. It details the efforts VIMS has made to track and monitor the Keypone contamination in the James River. Data was not analyzed for the last 10 years but new data measurements are available for the public. Some other interesting topics arise from this article including the availability for funding programs that test water quality and safety. There is also discussion about the ability for organizations like VIMS to monitor water quality and data based on measurement tools. Often, we base our measurements or readings on known contaminants, but little is done to test for new ones. You can read the full article here:
