SHEEPSHEAD

(Convict Fish) Archosargus probatocephalus

Description: a deep bodied fish that is grayish in color along the back and sides with a belly that is only slightly lighter in color; 5 to 6 black (or very dark brown) bars run down the sides; mouth is filled with formidable incisor and molar teeth; pectoral fin is long and pointed.

Similar Fish: Similar in body shape and size to several porgies; most similar in appearance to small black drum, but easily distinguishable by single dorsal fin structure (black drum have separate first and second dorsal fins), mouth with incisor



and molar teeth (black drum lack substantial teeth in their mouth, having crushing plates, called pharyngeal teeth, deep in their throat) and absence of chin barbels (black drum have pronounced chin barbels).

Size: up to 20 pounds; average size ranges from 2 – 8 pounds.

VBAC Fishing Roulette Challenge

In keeping with the mission of the Virginia Beach Anglers Club, "to promote fishing activities," the club started a friendly fishing competition for members only. This is our 10th year.

The Fishing Roulette

The purpose is to encourage our members to step outside their angler comfort zone and broaden their angling experiences by fishing for species or fishing in waters they would otherwise not consider. The Roulette rules were established with consideration of leveling the angler field; eligible species include both saltwater and freshwater varieties; accessible by shore or boat. The rules are simple. Any member in good standing has until the March meeting to enter the Roulette and pay their \$20.00 entry fee. At the March meeting, five species are randomly selected by spinning the roulette wheel from the list of club-eligible prize fish. All fish (aligned to the five selected species) caught in the period beginning January 1st through December 31st of that calendar year can be presented for the competition. Relying on the honor system for the Roulette, we only accept the weight of the fish. At the end of the year, the participant with the heaviest fish caught in each species category gets a share of the prize money. The prizes are based on the total sum of money collected divided by the number of species (1 winner per species).

Member of the Year

Purpose: This award recognizes an outstanding VBAC member who has given much time and effort to improving the quality of the VBAC. This award is not based on angling efforts and excludes from consideration those duties performed in conjunction with an elected office.

Format: The president appoints a committee chairperson on or about the October time frame. The committee chairman will select the remaining committee members (normally 2-3 persons). The president is a ex-officio member of this committee. At the December board meeting, the committee chairman proposes to the board a list of candidates for the award. The board can propose other candidates as well. Selection of the recipient is by ballot vote. The recipient must receive a majority vote of the board. The chairman keeps the name of the winner secret. This award may be won more than once by any member.

U.S. Coast Guard releases 2020 Boating Safety Statistics Report

WASHINGTON — The U.S. Coast Guard released its 2020 Recreational Boating Statistics Report Wednesday, revealing that there were 767 boating fatalities nationwide in 2020, a 25.1 percent increase from 2019.

From 2019 to 2020, the total number of accidents increased 26.3 percent (4,168 to 5,265), and the number of non-fatal injured victims increased 24.7 percent (2,559 to 3,191). There is evidence that boating activity increased significantly during the pandemic, from reports of increased boat sales, insurance policies taken out, insurance claims, and calls for towing assistance. With the increased exposure (i.e., more boating hours), there was greater risk of deaths, injuries, and accidents. The Coast Guard is analyzing variables associated with boating activity to normalize this accident data.

Alcohol continued to be the leading known contributing factor in fatal boating accidents in 2020, accounting for over 100 deaths, or 18 percent of total fatalities.

The report also shows that in 2020:

- The fatality rate was 6.5 deaths per 100,000 registered recreational vessels, the highest in the
 program's recent history. This rate represents a 25 percent increase from last year's fatality rate of
 5.2 deaths per 100,000 registered recreational vessels.
- Property damage totaled about \$62.5 million.
- Operator inattention, operator inexperience, improper lookout, excessive speed, and machinery failure ranked as the top five primary contributing factors in accidents.

Capt. Scott Johnson, chief of the Office of Auxiliary and Boating Safety at Coast Guard Headquarters, reflected on a number of cases where boaters had recently purchased the vessel involved in the incident, but had not taken many of the proper safety precautions before getting underway.

Where the cause of death was known, 75 percent of fatal boating accident victims drowned. Of those drowning victims with reported life jacket usage, 86 percent were not wearing a life jacket.

"It's crucial for boaters to wear a life jacket at all times because it very likely will save your life if you enter the water unexpectedly," said Johnson. "The Coast Guard reminds boaters to make sure that life jackets are serviceable, properly sized, and correctly fastened."

Where boating instruction was known, 77 percent of deaths occurred on vessels where the operator had not received boating safety instruction. The Coast Guard recommends that all boaters take a boating safety course that meets the National Boating Education Standards prior to getting out on the water.

The most common vessel types involved in reported accidents were open motorboats, personal watercraft, and cabin motorboats. Where vessel type was known, the vessel types with the highest percentage of deaths were open motorboats (50 percent), kayaks (15 percent), and pontoons (9 percent).

The report is based off on incidents that resulted in at least one of the following criteria: death, disappearance, injury that required medical treatment beyond first aid, damages to the vessel(s) or other property that equaled or exceeded \$2,000, or a loss of vessel.

The Coast Guard reminds all boaters to boat responsibly on the water: wear a life jacket, take a boating safety course, attach the engine cut-off switch, get a free vessel safety check, and boat sober.

"The Coast Guard thanks our boating safety partners," said Johnson, "they continue to demonstrate a committed effort to reduce loss of life, injuries and property damage through education and enforcement."

Please mail or email the completed forms by September 1, 2021. Should you later encounter a conflict that prevents you from serving, please advise us as soon as possible so we can search for a replacement.

Training will be provided at the Judges meeting held at 3:00 pm, on Wednesday, November 6th. Attendance is required. Judges will be reimbursed for gas used on Thursday and Friday only. Judges will be served a free lunch at the Club on Thursday and Friday. You will also be given complimentary tickets to attend Wednesday and Friday night events. As in the past, each judges will be assigned a location for the morning and afternoon sessions on Thursday, November 4th and Friday November 5th. Judges may fish for free in the Bob Bernard Open Individual Tournament on Saturday morning, November 6th.

Please note that the National Park Service requires an Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) permit for any vehicle driven on the beach of the Seashore. ORV permits must be purchased online at: http://www.recreation.gov. Type "Cape Hatteras N.S. ORV Permit" in the search box. This will take you to the correct permit page.


Fresh Water News






