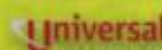



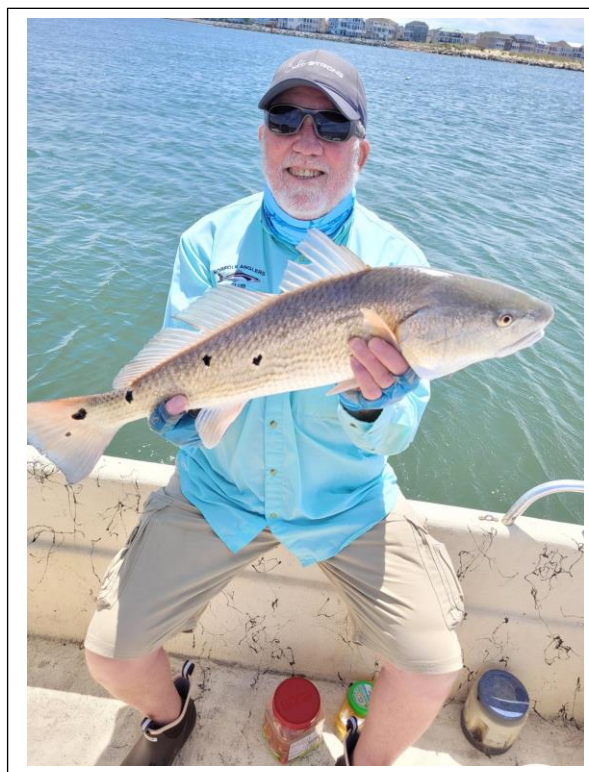
Saltwater Fishing News

On Friday, June 18, 2021 Dave Steele and I launched from Lynnhaven Marine in my boat on our first Cobia trip of the year. About an hour or so later Russell Willoughby and Jerry Hughes lunch from Crab Creek, Lynnhaven in Russell's boat and also headed to the shoals past the 4th Island. With an outgoing tide, Dave and I set up on the bay side of the 13 mile mark in about 15 feet of water. Stern into the bridge, we put out the obligatory chum pot, one rod behind the chum pot, 3 others on the bottom back in the chum slick and one floater rod with a small bunker. We fished that way to the tide turned and then repositioned to the ocean side, stern into the bridge. Russell initially set up at the 12 mile mark and switch to the 14 mile mark at the turn of the tide. Neither of us managed to snag the targeted fish that day. Caught plenty of skates, cow nose rays and one huge southern ray. Surprisingly we did not catch a shark.

The weather was great, bright sunshine and mild temperatures all except the south west/south east winds building to 15-20 knots in the early afternoon. While at anchor, the winds made for a very uncomfortable rolling/pitching deck. Two and three footers with a 7-8 second period. We both called it quits shortly after 1 in the afternoon. Russell head directly back from the 14 mile mark. Dave and I packed up and broke out the Spanish Mackerel gear. We headed south along the bay side of the bridge at 6 knots, down to the 2nd small boat channel past the 1st island and then turned towards Lynnhaven Inlet.. We fished 4 rods rigged with 2 number 1 planners and 2 inline sinkers. We used Drone Spoons on one side of the spread and various colored Clark Spoons on the other. The hot ticket was a small silver Drone Spoon with a red reflective strip off of the planer rod. Ended up with 5 nice Spanish for the day. The day started out poorly, but finished with a respectful catch.

Fishing Post Op with Louis.

Went fishing with Louis 5/27 in the Little Creek on his skiff. This was the first time I'd fished since 3 days preop May 4th before my hip replacement. I'd fished several times with him from February till May with my hip fractured which was always painful but this time it wasn't hurting near as much as before. Just muscle pain that I have been used more in the rehab work with my physical therapist. We fished the jetties in LC looking most of all for puppy drum which Louis got quickly but it was a short. I followed with an 18 inch speck on a white Gulp shrimp which guaranteed he and Hai had dinner. Beautiful day weather wise with blue skies and little NE winds. Now I'm ready for some more fishing without pain. We fished at high tide then as it started out..

First Puppy in 2021:

Went out with Louis again 6/2 looking for puppy drum. We were throwing white gulp on jigs and weren't catching anything in one area off of the east jetty in Little Creek. But when we went deeper further out from land on the jetty I started throwing a Salt Strong rubber bait that was silver on a jig and put some Dr. Juice attractant on it. As soon as the bait hit the water close to the jetty the fish took off and fought me for about 5 minutes going around the boat once. It was 25.5 inches long and ended up weight 6lbs when I cleaned it later. First red of the year and my PB.

Fishing with Russell in the Lynnhaven
6/24/21:

We went fishing for puppy drum in the Lynnhaven when the moon was full and a NE wind was holding the water in the river and left Crab Creek at 7am three hours before high tide.. We were sure the water would be higher than normal and the reds would be in the weeds. And they were!!! At our first stop Russell almost immediately hooked up a nice 24.5" puppy that ran all over the water and even jumped. He then hooked up one undersized fish from almost the same place. The next fish was a 20" inch fish that really put up a great run and fight all the way to the boat. Russell would ordinarily throwback that size fish but it was gut hooked and bleeding badly so it ended up in the box. Then he hooked another throwback. I was still working the other side for each weed line and getting harassed by crabs but no reds. We moved to another cove and again Russell was the hot fisherman with another 24.5 inch red. So since Russell had his limit he stopped fishing to give me a break. I casted my bait in the same spot Russell's last fish was caught and before too long I had a nice fighting puppy on my line that ended up in the boat measuring also 24.5 inch. But then nothing so we moved from cove to cove looking for some more so I could catch my limit. But by then the tide was high and not running and it was obvious the bite was over. All were caught on cut frozen mullet on Carolina rigs. They just would hit my gulp lure on a popping cork which usually attracts them. But 4 nice fish for about 4 hrs. fishing was well worth it. Thanks Russell!

Caught a lot of smaller fish, but the bite was light. I was drifting with 3 rods. Two with minnows and one with cut bait. Cut bait rod screamed out line. I thought it was a catfish with the head shakes. Was surprised to see a huge chain pickerel measuring 25 inches. It was worth the windburn to catch that fish. Melanie
