VBAC Summer Intraclub Surf Event Results

Our summer intraclub event was a tremendous event. 26 club members came out to enjoy the beautiful morning at the Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge. We had great weather, decent fishing, plenty of food and cold beverages for everyone in attendance. In total, 18 anglers scored 15 fish for 198 points!

The morning started with a 6:30AM check in. Anglers could enjoy a coffee and doughnut. There was also a little time to socialize and mingle before the 7:30AM Lines in. We filed on to the beach with a calm surf with a mild swell helping to stir up the sand along the beach. The water was a clean crystal green, especially when the sun was higher. Spanish could be seen all morning eating minnows on the surface right along the break but they just wouldn't eat any lures on the day. There was a good variety of bottom fish including bluefish, roundhead, spot, croaker and even a cobia caught! Ron had the largest catch of the day that included a 39 inch houndfish caught on a casting lure.

The most energetic moment of the day had to be when Caroline hooked into a good fighter. She ran up and down her stretch of beach a while until she landed a COBIA! It was an impressive little catch about 24 inches but unfortunately didn't score with our minimum size requirement as required by the state. It was released unharmed, unlike Kelly, who ended up with a hook through his middle finger after the cobia slipped out of his hand and hooked him with the other hook on the bottom rig. The head judge was quickly back in action after pulling it through and cutting the hook in half.

Fishing ended at 11:00AM. The crew gathered up all their gear and headed back to the parking lot. We enjoyed a feast of sandwiches and wraps, chips, cold watermelon, ice cold water and sodas, as well as some left over doughnuts from breakfast. There was a short awards presentation to the winners after a group picture. Thanks to our many judges and volunteers on the day as well as the numerous guests and family that came out to cheer on the competitors. Our 2nd Annual Stan Sutliff Memorial (fall intraclub) will take place on September 17, at the Little Island Park in Sandbridge.



Salt Water News

Team O'Relax was back for the 6th annual ODU Cobia Tournament held 7/15&7/16. This year's team included club members Chris Schneider, Gerry Mariano and Mike Anderson; being rounded out by a perennial favorite Tim Royster. This year's tournament Director was our very own Mark Lozier (this did nothing to help our cause).

Mid July cobia find themselves spread all over our waters. Over 64 boats registered for the event, made up of a good mix of site casters and us old diehard chunkers. Site casters rtely a bit more on the weather conditions, while chunkers rely on good bait and strong intel of where to find the fish. This year, finding fish wasn't tough, but knowing where the big ones were was tougher. Setting out to target our fishing to coincide with incoming waters, our seasoned crew confidently left the dock, set on owning the leader board. The weather was hot and so was the bite. Chum soaking in the water and fresh bunker dangling from our hooks, in no time reels began screaming with excitement. First 2 hits were hungry sharks with some girth on them. Next line to go screaming saw Gerry Mariano pounce on the rod with cat-like reflexes, much like a panther on the hunt. Liner was whisking off the reel, the fish was headed far away from the boat. Soon we had a leap, which confirmed we had the first cobia of the day. Gerry's fighting of the fish reminded me of a song by Toby Keith- "I'm not as young as I used to be"- but fortunately for us, the cobia tuckered out just before Gerry did. Boatside the fish looked pretty big, but a tuckered cobia is relatively easy to net. Once safely aboard, we measured our beast, which was a respectable 47" fish. We had one in the box, and were still positioned to be able to get us an even bigger fish (one fish over 50"). We boated 2 more cobia, but none were over 50", which was the prize we were looking for. The sharks wore everyone's arm off- they were hungry and relentless (we even used the Russ Willoughby shark release technique).

At 3pm we headed for the scales to get our fish weighed, high hook for the day was a 70 pounder with a couple of 50s thrown in. otherwise our fish was right in the mox of the typical fish of the day. We weighed in at 30 lbs-

Without discouragement, our team eagerly set out again on day 2 to find our 70 pounder. Well, the sharks once again prevailed, our 2 cobia were small. We retired for the day exhausted, but content with our effort over the 2 day tournament. We will surely prevail next year.






