

Wheel Spin Date: Thursday, March 3rd, 2022



The roulette wheel will be spun at the **March 3rd, 2022** membership meeting. You must declare your entry to the Prize Fish Committee **before** the spin of the wheel.

Roulette Information: To promote competitive fishing, the club devised a way to support fishing without providing an unfair advantage to any anglers. The solution involved a wheel that included a variety of freshwater and saltwater species in Virginia. The species are selected at random by spin of the roulette wheel. It costs \$20 for an angler to participate and each species winner receives an equal share of prize money.

Roulette Rules: Any fish caught from 1/1/2022 – 12/31/2022 can qualify. Only the **heaviest** fish in each category will win. Must have contacted the Prize Fish Committee to enter before the wheel is spun. Participants should provide payment as soon as possible. It is suggested that members mail a \$20 check to the club after registration for the roulette. You are required to submit your entry via the clubs standard Prize Fish form. Prize Fish/Roulette entries can be submitted in hand or by mail to the Virginia Beach Anglers Club Prize Fish Committee. A table of the current leaders will be kept up to date and posted in each newsletter. **Participants must be members in good standing with dues current.**



Gates open at 7:00 AM

Entry Fees: \$20.00 per Angler, \$10.00 for children under 16.

Registration: Register on day of tournament at judge's table before fishing.

Boat check before entering water.

Prize paid on the heaviest single fish.

Except for shore anglers, an angler may win only one place.

\$150.00 guaranteed 1st place, \$75.00 guaranteed 2nd place. Prizes can increase based on number of entrants. Shore anglers may win shore & crappie tournament prize. (see below).

Shore anglers may enter any fish caught during competition. A single prize will be awarded to the overall largest fish caught from shore irrespective of species. Should a crappie be caught by a shore angler, it may be entered in the tournament as a crappie catch in addition to entering for the shore prize.

Use of all nets (except landing net) will disqualify angler.

Early catch submission is permitted.

All entries must be in by 3:45 weigh-in time.

Ties will be decided by the earliest entry.

Decision of the weigh-master is final.



Salt Water News





- Fished today on my V14 Tracker with Ned Smith in the Elizabeth River and what a fabulous catching day it was!! Launched out of Great Bridge Locks with the water temp 41 degrees, air temp was 37 degrees but no wind. Started fishing near the Veterans Bridge and I caught a 17.5 inch speck on first cast. From that point on Ned and I began catching 20 specks: 17 inch to 24.25 inch one after the other, some times 2 at a time. That monster fish is the one posted here. That is Ned's release state citation fish.
- We only moved when the outgoing tide slowed. Fishing the Deep Creek produced 5 fish and one throwback, the only one for the whole trip. We later moved back to our starting place and caught 5 more. My biggest was 21.5 inches (the photo). All over 20 inch fish were released (5 Ned's, 4 mine). I kept 4 fish 18-19 inch. Most caught on Heavy Mirrodenes 18MR electric chicken & 808 colors.
- 30 keeper specks with one throwback and one state citation was a wonderful catching day.



Fresh Water News



A Crappie February Day:

Went fishing in my Tracker with Russell Willoughby to the Lake Smith looking for crappie. The temperature of the air had into the 50's a few days before and this one was supposed to be warm and low winds till around 4 pm. We launched at 11am with a water temperature of 50 degrees and almost no wind. We headed to Lake Larsen first. Within 10 minutes I had a 14 inch crappie that was fat. I wanted some eating fish so kept this one. But it was the only fish we caught there so we moved after an hour. Back in Lake Smith we went to some places where the lily pads are usually there but this early they weren't at the surface. This was the place to go. After Russell and I both hooked up a couple that got off in the lily pads we began to target where the pads weren't then we started catching keeper crappie and small bass. I kept 5 for dinner in the 12-14 inch then started releasing them. I released a 14 incher, two 13 inchers and a 12.5 inch club minimums. Russell was catching 11-12 inch fish and two largemouth bass one of which was 16 inch (in photo). I got a 15 inch bass myself that we released. But at one point Russell had a cast that was hanging over a branch of a fallen tree we were fishing by. He said as he was yanking on the line to free it the jig and shiner was dangling above the water when a chain pickerel came out of the water and grabbed the bait. That made for an exciting fight with that fish flying all around the boat but it didn't get our lines and went into the net (see picture). In all we caught about 18 crappie, three bass, and one chain pickerel all released but five crappie. All caught on shiners on chartreuse crappie jigs using ultra-light rods mostly. The bite turned off about 3:30pm when the wind shifted to the SE and increased to 15-20 making bobber fishing impossible. But a grand fishing day for February.




