Vacation in Florida 2022:

4/5/22

Kathy and I really enjoyed our time last year in Crystal River Florida at the Plantation but we really didn't get time to look around the area so we decided to go back this year. Crystal River is the home of the manatees with spring fed rivers and hundreds of mangrove islands with crystal clear water that snook love so they were my target species with secondary target of red drum and spotted seatrout (specks). I booked two half day trips with Capt. Glen Touchton whom I fished with last year when he put me on my first snook. On that trip my PB was a 29 incher, actually the first one I had ever hooked. You can only keep snook in Florida between 28-32 inches, one per day. The weather had been really bad the week before and it was still very windy this morning. Water level was really low giving us only 18 inches to 2 foot around the mangroves. With the high winds it made really hard to catch threadfin herring for live bait using sabicki rigs but he managed to get us two dozen from the gulf. At the mangroves the low water and high winds made it necessary to position with wind to our backs. On the first cast I had a solid snook on that measured out at 29.5 inches, my personal best and a guaranteed meal to be cooked for dinner at The Plantation at Crystal River (like we did last year). He fought like they usually do, airing several times and repeatedly trying to hide in the mangroves. We kept at this place and I promptly hooked up 4 more all slot fish but none bigger than my first caught. I actually lost the biggest one actually that jumped right at the boat and threw the hook. My guide said he was probably over slot 32+ inches. When the school moved on we decided to look for trout or reds but despite working several islands we just didn't find any. The winds by this time were running 18-25 mph so we headed in.

4/8/22

Despite hoping for the weather to cooperate it decided to stay the same with W winds 15-20 which again created low water. We even left the Plantation at 6AM before daybreak to avoid the wind predicted later but no such luck. This time Capt. Glen decided we'd use pinfish which he had in several traps he'd set previously in the Gulf. We had 30+ in no time then headed for the mangrove islands again. Low water was worse even when the prediction was for full high tide. But we persisted using the pinfish and rubber baits as well. Fishing live bait in the flats of Florida amounts to casting the baitfish close to the mangroves after quietly approaching the island with the electric trolling motor in about 12-18 inches of water. You can see the baitfish and you just have to keep the line as tight as possible without pulling or directing the bait. After about 2 hours fishing I noted my pinfish as was heading steadily towards me and right behind him was a huge fish. My guide said he thought it might be a shark but as soon as he grabbed my bait he took off on a long run, typical of big red drum. Thank goodness Captain Glen had bought brand new Shimano Stradic 4000 reels and matched them with 7'6" Star rods medium power, fast action. Because this red pushed that drag to the limit and with only 10 pound braid as a main line I was not going to try to horse it in like I would here at home with 50 lb braid and a medium heavy rod. But thank goodness that drag was a smooth as any reel I've ever used. After running back and forth and around the boat a few times he decided to try to go into the mangroves but I managed to angle him away from them. As he seemed to tire out and I got him closer to the boat Capt. Glen tried to net him. Each time he got close to the net he pulled away. But finally I got him head straight for the net but as his head went in he lunged and tore right though the net and took off on another run. So now I had a running over slot red drum with a net hanging on the braid as I again carefully attempted to ease him back to the boat. With no back up net lipping him with bota grips was the only solution. And amazingly Capt. Glen was able to do this in no time. I was by this time exhausted and could hardly hold that fish for pictures. He measured 35 inches and weighed 20 pounds on the bota grips.

After that fish we kept at that place and I soon hooked a snook. He provided a good fight but not as hard as that red. But this time we could only get it in the boat with bota grips so I had to fight him until we were sure he was tired and stopped tailing in the shallow water. This snook was 28.5 inches a slot fish and dinner for another day. The bite seemed to die so we worked several more islands to no avail. But I really felt lucky to have both of my targets done so in we went. Overall, not as many fish caught as last year but still my targets were caught and the whole trip otherwise went without a hitch.
