#### **ATTENTION ALL ANGLERS!**

The club is looking for members interested in fishing for our fall surf tournament teams. Each of our major fall tournaments have an opening on a surf team.

Hatteras Village (NC): Friday Sept 9 & Saturday Sept 10.

Long Beach Island (NJ): Saturday Sept 24.

Cape Hatteras (NC): Thursday Nov 3 & Friday Nov 4.

**Basic Tournament Format:** 

Tournaments last for two days with four fishing sessions. The tournament usually fishes either a Thursday, Friday, and/or Saturday. Club members drive their vehicle on the beach to their fishing spot and members without a vehicle can ride with those who have an ORV. The club rents a lodge for the team at a house and the lodge is available for you to stay the entire week (Sunday to Sunday).

New tournament anglers can get paired with a tournament veteran to help guide them through a tournament. This is a great opportunity to for you to meet club members with similar fishing interests. You can also receive assistance with rigs/bait/tackle/rods etc. as needed.

## **Proposed Right Whale Safety Changes Could Affect You.**

## **AGENCY:**

National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS), National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), Commerce.

### **ACTION:**

Proposed rule.

### **SUMMARY:**

NMFS is proposing changes to the North Atlantic right whale (*Eubalaena glacialis*) vessel speed regulations to further reduce the likelihood of mortalities and serious injuries to endangered right whales from vessel collisions, which are a leading cause of the species' decline and a primary factor in an ongoing Unusual Mortality Event. The proposed rule would: (1) modify the spatial and temporal boundaries of current speed restriction areas referred to as Seasonal Management Areas (SMAs), (2) include most vessels greater than or equal to 35 ft (10.7 m) and less than 65 ft (19.8 m) in length in the size class subject to speed restriction, (3) create a Dynamic Speed Zone framework to implement mandatory speed restrictions when whales are known to be present outside active SMAs, and (4) update the speed rule's safety deviation provision. Changes to the speed regulations are proposed to reduce vessel strike risk based on a coast-wide collision mortality risk assessment and updated information on right whale distribution, vessel traffic patterns, and vessel strike mortality and serious injury events. Changes to the existing vessel speed regulation are essential to stabilize the ongoing right whale population decline and prevent the species' extinction.

### Needs Survey – Harmful Algal Bloom Assessment and forecasting in Chesapeake Bay

#### **Dear VBAnglers,**

My name is Elizabeth 'Betty' Staugler, and I am a harmful algal bloom liaison (HAB) for the national Sea Grant network. I am working with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), and agencies and organizations in the Chesapeake Bay area to develop a workshop designed to advance harmful algal bloom assessment and forecasting in the Chesapeake Bay. We anticipate this workshop occurring in early 2023. As we plan this workshop, it is important for us to know what needs different water dependent users have for HAB detection and forecasting information. To help guide the workshop, we have developed a pre-workshop survey. This survey, which is anonymous, should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. One of our steering committee members provided your contact information and indicated that you might be willing to share this survey with the Virginia Beach Anglers Club membership via the Tightlines newsletter.

Your survey input is very important to us and the information provided will greatly improve the workshop that we develop. Thank you for taking the time to assist in this endeavor. If you require additional information or have questions, please contact me, Betty Staugler at <u>staugler@ufl.edu</u>.

As our offshore work on the Coastal Virginia Offshore Wind (CVOW) projects continues, we remain committed to maintaining communications with fishing communities and other mariners in the area via these periodic updates as well as dock visits, informational speaking engagements and additional information posted on the <u>CVOW website</u>.

All mariners are encouraged to contact Dominion Energy's Fisheries Liaisons below with any specific questions about the status of the projects in relation to fisheries.

#### Recent announcements include:

 Dominion Energy has initiated UXO Surveys within the export cable corridor (Areas A & B) and the Coastal Virginia Offshore Wind (CVOW) lease (Area C) and activities are expected to continue through 2022. The vessels being deployed and the areas to be surveyed are identified below.


Mariners transiting or fishing in the survey area are requested to provide a 0.5 NM wide clearance to survey vessels, which may have limited maneuverability due to towing gear up to 1,000' behind the vessel. Mariners should operate in a manner that will not endanger


themselves, the survey vessels, its crew or the equipment.



## Salt Water News

#### Lynnhaven puppies:

Russell got me out one day 8/12 in the morning when the NE wind was blowing keeping the water in the Lynnhaven at high tide. It was a beautiful day and Russell got the first fish, a 25 inch puppy drum at the first cove we ventured in within 15 minutes fish. We were using minnow under bobbers since the crabs were eating everything fished on the bottom. Then we proceeded to fish every cove we could think of for 3 hours before I caught the next one at 21 inches. Once the tide reached low we gave up. But it was a beautiful morning fishing. Thanks Russell.

#### Topwater Morning with Louis:

Despite my limited ability to get around with my broken hips Louis has been getting me out in his Carolina Skiff to fish the Little Creek at daybreak looking for the reds, blues and specks that show up when we use topwater lures. Most days we have been lucky to catch a few bluefish on topwater which is a blast. But on the 18<sup>th</sup> at daybreak I was lucky enough to hook a 26 inch puppy drum along with a limit of tailor bluefish. It smashed a Hadden One Knocker Spook and gave me a great fight at the last place we fished that day. We routinely fish the LC side of the jetties both in the channel and on the LCAC side and the point red marker.

Last week Louis and I fished three mornings in a row and consistently got a bluefish limit (3 per) or better. On the 25<sup>th</sup> I was lucky enough to hook a 23 inch striper who gave me a good fight and I quickly released it after we got the photo. I thought it was a speck at first. But regardless I caught an 18 inch speck a little later in addition to a limit of blues. Louis has been doing quite well with the blues and specks in both morning and sunset trips as well. The bite has been picking up and the bait is everywhere which is probably why we getting the variety now. Topwater action is the most fun since it's so visual and the blues are very likely to go airborne on you as you fight them. This has been a great week with the New Moon keeping the water high. Many thanks to Louis Glaser for getting me out to fish.






## **Salt Water News**






