- The winning fish must be brought to the weighmaster during Measure-In time. Fish not brought to the Measure-In will not qualify for a prize (except for the drum division).
- Anglers may submit a clear, sideview picture of their drum on a flat measure device as entry.
- Anglers can compete for and win more than one division.
- Prizes not awarded will be raffled amongst eligible anglers.
- Anglers are responsible for their own travel, fishing equipment, bait, ice and related expenses. Anglers should also have any appropriate licenses and permits required while fishing on the island.



### Catfish and White Perch Massacre; At Night

#### March 18, 2023

I went down to Edenton to spend the day with John and Stephanie. We did some work around the house and on the boat. The catfish were certainly hungry but I notice that the larger fish don't appear to be as active. I believe they are bedding and preparing to spawn. Lots of smaller cats in the 20-24" range seem to be dominating lately. We were also catching a lot of white perch and the bite seemed to be best at night. I have not encountered white perch this active at night before. I took a mess of white perch and catfish home that was put away for later. The catfish have been full of clams lately. Some having hundreds of baby clams in their digestive tracks.





### **Surf Fishing News**

### Sharkin' and Catfishin' with Wesley

#### March 26, 2023

Wesley and I made the early morning drive to Hatteras on Sunday morning. We stopped at my normal spring time shark beach. I was hoping for some good shark fishing and that is exactly what we found. In 1 minute and 42 seconds, my first drum rig was hammered hard by a large sandbar. I tried to break it off but was not successful. We spent nearly 20 minutes fighting the shark on puppy drum gear and eventually beached it. It was measured at 70.5" and was my first shark of the season. We encountered a ton of shark bites on the day. Wesley caught a 76.5" sandbar just as the rain and storms were moving in on us. We packed up and got off the beach just in time!

After dodging a few storms, we found our way to Edenton. The ground was soaked from hours of rain but the fish were already wet. We sent out some catfish lines and caught about 10 catfish in 5 hours. It was a lot of fun to relax and enjoy the fire pit with some good friends. I managed one 26" catfish that was 9 lb 2 oz with a full belly of roe and an 18 shad stuffed in the belly. I did later find the tail sticking out of the throat. Proof that these creatures are vacuum cleaners and need to be removed from the all local waterways. We made the drive home and the 20 hour trip was a tremendous success. Looking forward to the spring shark bite in hatteras throughout the month of April!

"I was out there practicing for a tournament, catching a bunch of fish," said Moore, who works as an arborist and participates in local tournaments. "I was on the lower James near Chippokes [State Park]. When I hooked into that one, I thought I had a saltwater fish on at first, but lo and behold, it was a largemouth! A very different largemouth, though. I haven't seen anything like that before. I've seen bass with black spots, but I'd never seen an albino one."




