Time: Lines in 8:00AM – Final turn-in for fish 4:00 PM. Prizes will be awarded at 5:00 PM.

Location: Lake Smith.

Gates open at 7:00 AM.

Captain's meeting at registration table at 7:30 AM.

Entry Fees: \$20.00 per Angler, \$10.00 for children under 16.

Registration: Register on day of tournament at judge's table before fishing.

Boat check before entering water.

Prize paid on the longest single fish. Length measurement rounded off to nearest 1/4".

Early catch submission is permitted either in person or by text photo submission (photo instructions and verification item will be given to each angler at registration on March 18 at ramp). Verification item must appear in all submissions. If angler is keeping fish, please wait and submit the largest fish caught. All others may submit as fish is caught.

#### Except for shore anglers, an angler may win only one place.

\$150.00 guaranteed 1st place, \$75.00 guaranteed 2nd place. Prizes can increase based on number of entrants. Shore anglers may win shore & crappie tournament prize. (see below).

Shore anglers may enter any fish caught during competition regardless of species. A single prize will be awarded to the longest fish caught from shore irrespective of species. Should a crappie be caught by a shore angler, it may be entered in the tournament as a crappie catch in addition to entering for the shore prize.

Use of all nets (except landing net) will disqualify angler.

Ties will be decided by the earliest fish entered. Decision of the weigh-master is final.

## **Freshwater News**

Here are two days of fishing that produce club minimums. The pic of Russell with the 13.5 in was caught on 1/24 not 1/5 as the attachment says.:

Crappie fishing on Lake Smith/Lawsen 1/20 and 1/24/23

Russell and I went fishing for black crappie out of Lake Smith's ramp on 1/20. Really nice weather with low winds and 50s temperatures lured us out on the water and it wasn't disappointing each time. On 1/20 Russell caught a 13 inch and 11.5 inch club minimum release and I caught a 12 inch club minimum release along with 4 keeper crappie each around 10-11 inches long and several throwback sized crappie, yellow perch and chain pickerel. Water temperature was 49-51 degrees and we used medium sized shiners for bait. We fished both Smith and Lawsen lakes.

On 1/24 the afternoon wind was low and it was sunny but colder so we tried again for black crappie at Smith/Lawsen in the afternoon hours.. The bite was much slower than last week and it really wasn't until after 3pm that we scored. Russell had a 13.5, 12.5 and 11.5 inch club minimum releases while I had a 12.5, 11.5 and 11 inch club minimum releases. All fish caught on shiners hooked on jigs with various colored Bobby Garlands.

Went fishing with Phil on January 11 at Walkers Dam, Chickahominy river. He had a few special areas there that he liked. We trolled for hours, marking fish but no bites until 3 pm. I got a 13 and a half inch crappie and a 13 inch crappie. Phil got one that was even bigger, but he released without measuring. I caught one more, but gave it to people that had just started fishing. Water was 45 to 46 degrees, but the bite did not start until the tide was almost full. It was supposed to be a warm day, but never got there. Melanie

## **Saltwater News**

#### Winter Catfishing in NC

Dec 31 - Went down for a New Years Eve celebration in Edenton, N.C. I brought some live eels and a couple of rods to play with some catfish. The daytime bite was a bit slow as it usually is. The evening bite turned out to be incredibly strong. From about 5 pm until 1 am, the lines were going down every 15 minutes with another catfish. We've been catching a lot of larger blue catfish in the evening hours with a mix of white cats. Channel cats have mostly been dominating in the day time. My first catfish of 2023 was caught just minutes after midnight. I filleted all the catfish on new years day and bagged over 34 pounds of meat from 12 catfish. It was all given away in a matter of hours.





Jan 22 – Headed to Edenton with Alex and Ron to get in on some catfishing opportunities. A heavy south wind and rain was expected with an approaching cold front. The daytime bite turned out very slow. We only had a handful of bites before sunset. The blue cats were waiting for dark. They came out in a fury and were grabbing lines every 5 to 10 minutes. Alex beached nearly every catfish hooked over the weekend. His largest was about 29" and weighed just short of 10 pounds! The average blue cat weighed nearly about 8 pounds. Each blue catfish caught there is bled and iced. We filleted 3 of the catfish for dinner and saved 6 others for cleaning the next day. I was able to get 17 pounds of meat from the 6 catfish brought home. A couple of catfish meals were cooked and some fillets were given away. There is still no room in the freezer for catfish filets. I'm always working to give the meat away to anyone that is interested.

Looking forward to the February 25<sup>th</sup> Catfish Tournament at the same location I've been encountering these catfish!










