# Fresh Water News

Fished Beaverdam Monday, Dec 5 with Phil Brewer. Water was 50 degrees and bite was slow with winds higher than "light and variable". We went into an arm of the lake with less wind and caught white perch and one crappie. I put down a small piece of cut bait and thought I had a load of hydrilla. Caught a 12" yellow perch wrapped in the hydrilla. That beautiful fish made it worth being windblown and chilly that day.

Phil Brewer had fished Beaverdam reservoir with another buddy on Sunday, Dec 11, and they caught some big bass. On Tuesday the the 13th, he took me to the area where the bass had been. It was a cold, slow fishing day with a few perch caught when the rod finally went down big time. I thought it was a catfish. Reeled it up easy with 4 lb test line and was surprised to see a big bass. Phil netted it and when I went to unhook the fish, the line parted. Whew! Was a big fat 6 pounder.
