

The Cape Hatteras Anglers Club Invitational Surf Tournament is the largest team surf event in the world. It hosts 120 teams of 6 for a total of 720 anglers and nearly 75 volunteers during the tournament. The tournament is scattered along many of the best beaches in Hatteras. It encompasses a range of 25+ miles from ramp 23 all the way down to ramp 49. Teams fish four sessions. Two of these sessions are north of the point and two of these sessions are south of the point.

Men's Team Report:

It was another fabulous tournament for the Virginia Beach Anglers Club. We've once again proved that the club has many great anglers that consistently produce year over year. Both of our teams almost always finish in the top 25% of nearly every tournament of the year.

The weather this year was windy and cold. A big cold front came through on Tuesday which dipped temperatures into the 40s and 50s for Hatteras early in the week. Much of the tournament featured north winds around 20 bringing cooler, but above average water temperatures. While some teams encountered some bluefish, very few were scored this year. Many of the best scores were from roundhead and black drum. That turned out to be the case for our men's team as well.

We started south of the point on day one. Relatively calm conditions and dirty water existed on the south end of the fishing grounds. That's common for south beaches on a hard Northwest wind. We managed to find a few scattered fish on both sessions down there but found little quality. As usual, the north beaches were the best for us. Rougher and cleaner water brings in the fish to feed along the beaches. Our Thursday afternoon session was on ramp 23. We had some very beautiful water with big breakers tight to the beach but found almost nothing. One fish kept us from being blanked on the score board.

Friday morning was a different day with much different results. We found a nice little hole on ramp 38 during the 3rd session of the tournament that produced a lot of fish on bloodworms. Russell got into a 22" black drum that scored 16 points! Wesley also caught a few roundhead that scored 9 points to help elevate the team from our poor day one. In all, we scored 10 fish for 33 points on Friday morning. It was our best session of the tournament.

Russell's 22" black drum ended up awarding him a tie for the largest other scoring fish of the tournament. Another angler registered a 22" black drum on Thursday that was the same size. Way to go Russell!

We had a great time as a team. I would like to thank Robbie for running his captains duties efficiently and the team for fishing hard. Doug should also be commended as he had spent some time looking through old photos to produce a slide show of surf tournaments and events from decades in the past. It was fun to see some of the memories of our most accomplished anglers.




Cape Hatteras Invitational: A Summary

On November 3rd, 2023, history was made. The Virginia Beach Anglers Club's (VBAC) very own ladies' team triumphed in the Cape Hatteras Invitational, taking first place in the women's division. Finishing in tenth place out of 118 teams total, this was the first time in VBAC history an all-female team represented the club in any tournament. Ever. We were not only delighted to learn we were getting our own team, but that we would be getting our own house, too! We all knew of the challenge that lay ahead of us, for years of experience and training had prepared us for the tourney. We could not have asked for better conditions. We cast our lines, watching the sun rise out of the ocean. All that was left to do now was pray to the Fish Gods. Little did we know they would answer with Mullet, and lots of it! Scoring eighty-six points overall, the VBAC Ladies caught forty-two fish during the two-day tournament. Top angler Patty Searby reeled in thirteen Mullet, for twenty-nine points. Close behind Searby was Jennie Braithwaite, catching ten Mullet, scoring twenty-two points. Melanie Bayford caught nine Mullet, racking up seventeen points. All of us anglers fished hard until the very end, with Micky Walsh reeling in the final Mullet as the horn was blown at four o'clock. It was truly an honor to accomplish this goal with my sister, Elizabeth Nash, alongside me. As the Captain, I could not be more proud to be a part of this team. I would like to give special thanks to the Virginia Beach Sand Witches, because without them, this victory would not have been possible. I would additionally like to thank my team members for all of their hard work and dedication. We did it!
