September is upon us and the temperatures will finally start cooling down. I follow fishing from Key West to Martha's Vineyard and I have to say, what I read is a lot of the same thing I hear said around here. "It is not as good as it was a number of years ago" and " Back in the day we used to slay them". But what I do see and know is that fishing comes and goes in cycles. For example, tuna fishing offshore has not been very productive the last two years from Ocean City, MD to Cape Hatteras like it used to be. We would have Tuna lined up and down the dock. Now you are lucky to catch 3 or 4 on a day trip. Locally, we haven't caught big bluefish and large red drum from the surf or boat in a number of years, but this year they were here. Hopefully that is a sign that the Striped Bass might return, who knows. But what I do know is that if we practice sensible conservation, the fish that we do have will be around a little longer. Keep only what you are going to eat. Handle a fish as little as possible, try not to stress it out then release it unharmed. Lots of activities going on in September and October, take advantage of them. Wishing you all fair winds, following seas and tight lines.


