Check-In

Check-in begins at 3:00pm. Please be prepared to pay for your cabin, ry, or tent site at that time. Only 2 vehicles are allowed to park at each cabin. Additional parking is available in front of the campground headquarters. A campground map will be provided when you check in.

Event Participation Fee: \$25 per pp

An event participation fee of \$25 will be due as cash or check when you arrive. See Bob Burstein. The event participation fee is payable to VBAC and not part of your check-in with the Frico Woods Campground. Your fee includes all VBAC organized activities. Youth 15 years old and under are free.

Hospitality Tent

Wesley Waters has stepped up to provide a hospitality tent. It will be set up Friday afternoon through Sunday. The hospitality tent will include water, soda, and some grab-n-go snacks. This tent is provided as a break area for weekend participants. It will be located near the center of our reservation section near cabins 9 and 16. The beach/sound access in the back of the campground has been bulkheaded. It is unknown if there are opportunities for anglers to walk around in the water like last year.


Each cabin has 2 parking spots. Additional vehicles should park out in front of the office.

- To be eligible, all fish must meet state regulation size minimums to qualify.
- This is a LENGTH ONLY Tournament. Fish scores will be based on TOTAL LENGTH.
- Tournament submissions may be entered via Text, Email or at the Measure-In.
- Surf Text Submissions: 757-416-8817
- Pier Submissions: Bob Burstein 267-994-7423 Text only with photo.
- Email Submissions: Fishnkelly@msn.com
- Anglers should provide a clear, sideview picture of their fish on a flat measure device if the fish is released and photographic entry is used.
- Adult anglers can compete for and win more than one division.
- In the event of a tie, the first fish caught and scored will be the winner.
- Prizes not awarded will be raffled at the tournament banquet.
- Anglers are responsible for their own travel, fishing equipment, bait, ice and related expenses. Anglers should also have any appropriate licenses and permits required while fishing on the island.

- Spanish/Bluefish/Bonita
- Red Drum/Black Drum/Speckled Trout/Grey Trout/Sheepshead

Tournament Boundaries:

- Anglers are allowed to fish from Oregon Inlet to Hatteras Inlet and at the Avon Pier
- Fishing is allowed on all oceanside beaches and soundside shorelines ONLY.
- Fish caught from docks, bridges, jetties, kayaks, or boats DO NOT QUALIFY.






