Following the start of the 3pm weigh-in boats started lining up with plenty of cobia to be placed on the scales. Roughly 60% of the boats came back with a cobia to compete for the prizes. While most fish teetered in that 20 lb class (+- a pound) the top three fish distinguished themselves beating the pack with some heavy fish.

Third Place fish weighing 29 lb, 1 ounce caught by Captain Aubry Williams team netted them \$300.00.


Second Place fish weighing 40 lb, 1 ounce caught by Captain Rudy Levassuer's team netted them \$500.00.


