## **Event Details**

### **Event Participation Fee: \$25 per person**

An event participation fee of \$25 will be due as cash or check when you arrive and check-in for the weekend. Your fee includes all VBAC organized activities. Youth 15 years old and under are free.

### Check-In

Bob Burstein will have a table set up at the Frisco Woods Campground headquarters for all cabin reservations. Check-in begins at 3:00pm. Please be prepared to pay for your cabin and your event participation fee at that time. Only 2 vehicles are allowed to park at each cabin. Additional parking is available in front of the campground headquarters. A campground map will be provided when you check in.

### **Hospitality Tent**

Wesley Waters has stepped up to provide a hospitality tent. It will be set up Friday through Sunday. The hospitality tent will include water, soda, and some grab-n-go snacks. This tent is provided as a break area for weekend participants. It will be located near the center of our reservation section near cabins 9 and 16. We will pull the hospitality tent up Sunday morning prior to check-out.

### Friday Evening Social

Mary Bradley has organized a Friday Evening Social for our members and guests to relax. It will run from approximately 7:00pm to 9:00pm. The event will be held at the campground recreation center. We'll have a firepit, some soda and water, as well as s'mores for camp-goers to enjoy. This is a great opportunity to meet all the participants and make some arrangements to fish together on Saturday!

### **Mark Wray Memorial Fishing Tournament**

Kelly Hoggard is our tournament chairman for the fishing tournament. Our 12-hour fishing tournament on Saturday is nearly identical to last year's. Lines-In at 5:00am and Lines-Out at 5:00pm. There are 4 different species divisions available as well as a youth division. The winning fish will be determined by length. Please read our tournament rules and guidelines flier.

### **Saturday Banquet**

Patty Searby is headlining our show once again! She'll be providing a cajun seafood boil. The boil will consist of shrimp, andouille sausage, corn and potatoes. Please be respectful of the campground and all other campers! Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. If you have any questions or issues at any time, reach out and contact me directly.



### **Frisco Woods Campground Rules**

We want everyone to enjoy their stay so please follow our park rules:

- Quiet hours are from 11pm to 8am.
- **Pets are welcome with a fee**. All pets are required to be kept on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet waste bags are located throughout the campground.
- **Ground Fires** are strictly prohibited. Charcoal fires in grills, gas grills, camp stoves, or fire containers only. All camp fires must be elevated.
- Trash Please place all garbage in bags and dispose of in dumpsters provided.
- Speed limit throughout the park is 5 mph.
- Pool hours are from 9am to Dusk. No exceptions. There is no lifeguard on duty.
- **Refunds** No cash or credit refunds will be given for campers who wish to check out prior to their pre-paid registered check-out date.
- Discharge of fireworks or firearms is not permitted.
- The facilities are furnished solely for the convenience of our guests. All persons using these facilities do so at their own risk. Management is not responsible for accidents, injury, or loss of personal property due to weather conditions, fire, theft, or vandalism.
- Plants trees and wildlife are all part of a preservation effort here at Frisco Woods Campground. They are to be enjoyed and not destroyed or damaged during your stay.
- Washing of any vehicle is not permitted. Please help conserve water.
- Golf carts must be PARKED by 10pm and driven by no one under the age of 16 without legal guardian on board!
- Bicycles, scooters, and skateboards are not allowed to be ridden after dark unless they have lights.
- This is a ZERO TOLERANCE policy and failure to abide may result in removal from campground without a refund and being BANNED from future reservations.
- Parents, it is your responsibility to watch and control your children. You will be held accountable for damages. For example, climbing on top of the swing set is unacceptable.
- It is early in the season and we have already had these issues. Everyone's safety is our top priority. We are simply asking for compliance to keep everyone safe.

### **Tournament Headquarters:** Frisco Woods Campground Pavilion

- Open to VBAC Members, Family, and Invited Guests.
- To be eligible, all fish must meet state regulation size minimums to qualify.
- This is a LENGTH ONLY Tournament. Fish scores will be based on TOTAL LENGTH.
- Tournament submissions may be entered via Text, Email or at the Measure-In.
- Text Submissions: 757-416-8817
- **Email Submissions:** Fishnkelly@msn.com
- Anglers should provide a clear, sideview picture of their fish on a flat measure device if the fish is released and photographic entry is used.
- Adult anglers can compete for and win more than one division.
- In the event of a tie, the tying prizes will be split among the winning anglers.
- Prizes not awarded will be raffled at the tournament banquet.
- Anglers are responsible for their own travel, fishing equipment, bait, ice and related expenses. Anglers should also have any appropriate licenses and permits required while fishing on the island.

### **Tournament Divisions:**

- 1- Roundhead/Pompano
- 2- Spanish/Bluefish
- 3- Red Drum/Black Drum
- 4- Bonita/Bonito/Cobia/Croaker/Grey Trout/Sheepshead/Speckled Trout/Spot
- 5- Youth Division Any qualifying fish in the above categories

### **Tournament Boundaries:**

- Anglers are allowed to fish from Oregon Inlet to Hatteras Inlet.
- Fishing is allowed on all oceanside beaches and soundside shorelines ONLY.
- Fish caught from piers, docks, bridges, jetties, kayaks, or boats DO NOT QUALIFY.

### Team O'Relax by Chris Schneider


After an extended winter hiatus, because the wind wouldn't stop blowing Team O'Relax is back. Team O"Relax consisting of George Gabriel, Mike Anderson, Jerry Mariano and myself. We needed to get the dust knocked off and the kinks worked out as a team, we were preparing for the East Cobia Championship and the ODU tournament. So at 0800 on May 28th we headed out across the bay to Fisherman's Island in search of big red drum. There was hardly a ripple on the bay except for the wake a submarine left as it returned to port. We set up on the ocean side of fishermans Island using clams. eels and crabs. Unfortunately, after 3 hours we didn't have a bite so we packed up and headed to the bay of the bridge and fisherman's island, Again not a bite so after an hour and a half we moved once again to the bay side of the bridge tunnel (sorry specific location will not be revealed). We put out our baits, but this time we added last year's menhaden to the mix. It wasn't long till the action began, first up was Jerry with a nice 46 inch Cobia. The fish was so cooperative as we were getting it in the net the tip of the hook broke and the fish swam away nicely. Next up was myself, my Cobia decided it wanted to see all of the Chesapeake Bay and tangle up everyone's line before we had a chance to clear them all. Then decided it should jump out of the water a few times. Finally tiring out we got it in the net and it measured 44 inches and released unharmed. Next up was George with another screaming Cobia . George fought it expertly and Mike netted it like a pro. It measured in at 47 inches and released. Mike was next up, his fish was a beast but he handled it with no problems, George netted it and it measured in at 48 inches, but this fish was fat. Just to let you know, now we weren't just catching Cobia in the middle of all this and while fighting Cobia we were catching sharks and big rays. It was kind of comedic at times, as our lines were all tangled up, but we needed this to get back in sync with each other of what to do during a tournament. It really was great practice and a lot of fun. We managed to catch 3 more Cobia that day. A total of 7 Cobia between 36 and 48 inches. We never did find a Red Drum, but things happen for a reason.

# Surf Fishing/ Ocracoke

Fishing Report: Ocracoke Invitational Surf Fishing Tournament (OISFT)

Well - the weather was Great! The fishing not so much. VBAC TEAM 1 made a Very respectable showing. They finished in 6<sup>th</sup> place out of 77 teams, up 4 teams from last year's 73 teams. Our very own surf fisherman extraordinaire, Kelly Hoggard, had the most scoring fish of any other male angler in the tournament with 6 scoring fish. To show the effort put out by the team, they scored 11 fish for 53 points. The winning team only had 2 fish (a 44" red drum & a 33" bluefish) for 131 points. Sometimes it pays to be in the right place at the right time! Congratulations to TEAM 1! And to Kelly for his great accomplishment of scoring the most fish by a male angler! Well done.

Team 2 did not fare so well. We tied with 38 other teams for 40<sup>th</sup> place with 0 points. We had ok sites on Thursday but no fish. The Friday sites looked really good. The water had cleared up and looked like prime bluefish water but someone, the team captain, (me) forgot to tell the bluefish! Skunked again Friday. We fished hard in all 4 sessions trying everything we had to throw at them (cut bait, bloodworms metal, etc.) but nothing was there to eat it. Bill Dawson did manage to catch 3 flounders over the 2 days of fishing, but they were out of season and not scorable. We saw only a few fish caught by other teams up and down the beach so we were not alone. So again, the weather was great, the comradery wonderful, and Ocracoke Village unique place to be. I would definitely put my name in the pot to go again!









Post Ocracoke Tournament Fishing Report:








Jay Graber submitted the following piece.






