A couple of crews made their way out to the high rise area and were rewarded with decent catches of flounder and a grey triggerfish. As for our club; the captains included Preston Mangum, Chris Schneider, George Gabriel and Mike Anderson. All four boats found their way around Lynnhaven inlet looking for anything willing to bite. At one point, all four boats were within a couple hundred yards enjoying a little club comradery.

As a group, fishing was a little bleak. Mike Anderson and myself started the day in the rain and found a small hole with some larger croaker and spot. Mikes .46 pound spot later scored on the final board for 1 point. A closely guarded secret was spoiled as Mike and I stopped in a supposed flounder hot spot and found a nice 18.5 inch flounder. Good for 2 points as the second largest fish scored in the tournament. Compliments go to David Reynolds for giving away his super-secret location!

The lowlight of the day went to myself when I was playing around with the anchor line and fell into the water. I lost both a \$400+ pair of prescription sunglasses and fried my Iphone. The phone has since been replaced by a newer model.

The winner for this year's tournament was TKAA.. aka: those pesky kayak guys (Mark Lozier; our monthly speaker was included in those bunch of hardheads). 




